Liberty is the ability of an individual to pursue their own goals with minimal interference from outside forces. Democracy is rule by the people, where there is a rule of law that allows all people to elect accountable leaders. In a democracy there will necessarily be compromises to individual freedoms for the better of the whole. The belief that freedom consists of being free of interference from outside individuals (and government) is known as negative liberty. So democracies naturally oppose negative liberty.
